At the outset, I would like to take this opportunity of wishing you and your family season's greetings and a healthy happy prosperous New Year.

Having spent a decade in the United Kingdom, I returned to India with a Vision and a Mission. How have I done thus far? I asked myself this question after completing one year of homecoming.

I set myself three goals well before returning to India...

- 1. To establish a Breast Cancer Foundation
- 2. To establish a Specialist Breast Centre in Hyderabad
- To empower women about the importance of breast awareness & breast screening in Andhra Pradesh

1. Breast Cancer Foundation

After considerable thought and planning, **Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation** was established as a registered charity in September 2007.

The Foundation set up collaboration with **Breast Cancer** Care UK, an organisation that has a track record of providing breast cancer information and support across the United Kingdom for the past three decades.

The principal aim of this collaboration is to make available Information Booklets in India on every aspect of breast cancer and also about a range of benign breast health issues in simple, easy to understand language. This is the FIRST time ever, for Breast Cancer Care, UK to collaborate with an overseas Breast Cancer Foundation. The booklets have been widely circulated in Andhra Pradesh and are available on Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation website (www.breastcancerindia.org)

My heartfelt appreciation is due to my childhood friend, Satish Reddy, M.D and Chief Operating Officer of Dr. Reddy's Laboratories for wholeheartedly supporting my vision, and equally, playing a key role to ensure my dream of establishing the Breast Cancer Foundation turns into a reality. I would like to acknowledge the outstanding contribution from Dr.R.V.Rao, a renowed Medical Oncologist, my colleague and friend, for taking an active role in the strategic development of Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation.

2. Specialist Breast Centre in Hyderabad

I have conceived, visualised and designed KIMS - USHALAKSHMI Centre for Breast Diseases, a unique initiative of Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences (KIMS) in Hyderabad - FIRST of its kind in the Indian Subcontinent.

Clinical assessment, breast imaging and breast biopsy including stereotactic biopsy and counseling are all offered in this purpose built, free standing Breast Centre. KIMS has also achieved the unique distinction to become the FIRST Hospital in South India & the only Centre in Andhra Pradesh to have acquired Full Field Digital Mammography System - an incredible advance in detecting early breast cancer.

About 1500 women from Hyderabad underwent FREE Breast Cancer screening since October 2007 in collaboration with Jarvis Breast Screening Centre in London - the FIRST international partnership of its kind in India. Six impalpable cancers were detected and treated through this initiative.

3. Empowering women....impacting life

With the singular aim of empowering women about breast awareness and the benefits of breast screening, I have delivered 'invited lectures' at meetings arranged by 50 different organisations across Andhra Pradesh. On the eve of International Women's Day, on 7th March, 2008, an event was organized to celebrate the birth of KIMS-USHALAKSHMI Centre for Breast Diseases. Speaking on this occasion, Mrs. Jeannie Mulford, a breast cancer survivor and wife of Dr. David Mulford, United States Ambassador to India complimented the pioneering work done at the Breast Centre in KIMS.

She went on record to state..

"Your story is one that I will repeat many times when I speak with breast cancer survivors here in India and in the United States."

This was certainly a touching testimony to my focused efforts over the past one year since returning to my motherland.

Breast Cancer awareness took centre stage in Hyderabad during the Breast cancer awareness month (October 2008). On 1st October 2008, Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation organized a PINK RIBBON EVENING. Two eminent breast cancer survivors shared their experiences of battling and surviving breast cancer. Their crystal clear message about the importance of being breast aware was the highlight of the Event.

On 24th October 2008, the legendary pop group Boney M featuring Marcia Barrett performed live for the FIRST time ever in Hyderabad at the Pink Ribbon Nite organised by Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation. Being a breast cancer survivor herself, Marcia Barrett's performance aimed to celebrate, recognize and pay tribute to all those who have been affected with breast cancer, and equally, bring about breast cancer awareness through the medium of music. Dr. David Mulford and his wife, Mrs. Jeannie Mulford were the Chief Guests at the Concert. This landmark Event was unique in that a breast cancer survivor performed live for a Breast Cancer Foundation during the 'breast cancer awareness' month with an eminent breast cancer survivor as the Guest of honour.

I am delighted that both Ushalakshmi Breast Cancer Foundation and KIMS-USHALAKSHMI Centre for Breast Diseases have well and truly set a benchmark in the delivery of Breast Healthcare in India.
